

Holy Innocents' Episcopal School

Fulton County, Georgia

Holy Innocents' Episcopal School is a church-related day school enrolling students from preschool through Grade 12. It is located on a 30-acre campus in the suburban Sandy Springs area of Fulton County, Georgia.



The school opened in 1959. In 1989, the school acquired the adjacent property that housed the Riley School and began an expansion program. Pharr Engineering was brought on board to provide sitework engineering for the conversion of the existing building, the parking lot reconfiguration, and the

construction of a state-of-the-art track and athletic field. Since that time, Pharr has continued to provide Holy Innocents' with civil engineering services for their many expansions and additions. These expansions and additions include the construction of a gymnasium, baseball fields, a day care center, another classroom expansion, a new library, and an Episcopal Youth Center Pavilion. Pharr continues to assist Holy Innocents' in master planning, land acquisition, and zoning issues.
